A PoE switch can power and connect AP panels using a single Ethernet cable per AP, ensuring both data and power delivery while simplifying network deployment.

Overview of PoE Switch and AP Panel Connection

A PoE (Power over Ethernet) switch integrates network switching and power delivery, allowing Ethernet cables to transmit both data and DC power to devices like wireless APs, IP cameras, or VoIP phones. AP panels, often used in office or enterprise environments, can be connected directly to PoE switch ports, enabling plug-and-play deployment without separate power lines.

Key Steps for Setup

- Select the Correct PoE Standard**
 - IEEE 802.3af: Provides up to 15.4W per port.
 - IEEE 802.3at (PoE+): Provides up to 30W per port.Ensure the AP panel's power requirement matches the switch port's output.
- Use Proper Cabling**
 - Use 8-core Ethernet cables (Cat5e or higher) for simultaneous data and power transmission.
 - High-quality, oxygen-free copper cables are recommended to reduce power loss and ensure stable connectivity.
- IP Address and Network Configuration**
 - Assign unique IP addresses to each AP panel to avoid conflicts.
 - Configure APs in the same VLAN if they are part of the same network segment.
 - For fat APs, initial configuration may require logging into the AP's management interface to set SSID, encryption, and IP settings.
- Physical Connection**
 - Connect the AP panel directly to a PoE-enabled port on the switch.
 - For larger deployments, multiple APs can be connected to a PoE switch, which in turn connects to the core router or integrated AC controller.
- Network Management**
 - Managed PoE switches allow centralized monitoring, port power prioritization, and cluster management, improving stability and troubleshooting.
 - Ensure firmware of both APs and switches is up to date to prevent connectivity issues.
- Troubleshooting Tips**
 - If an AP shows "not connect" status or fails to receive power, check:
 - Port configuration and VLAN assignment.
 - Cable quality and length (PoE typically supports up to 100 meters).
 - Power budget of the switch to ensure...
