- Protective Measures:** If the cable remains outside for extended periods, protective material should cover it to prevent environmental damage. LSZH sheathed cables are sensitive to mechanical stress, so careful handling is essential.
- Temperature Considerations:** Installation and storage temperatures must comply with the cable specifications to avoid damage to the sheath or fibers.
- Clean Handling:** The cable end should be kept clean, often using a plastic sheet on the ground, to prevent dirt or debris from contaminating the fiber during deployment.
