- Add insurance cost, usually calculated as a percentage of the total value (commonly 0.5–2% depending on risk and route).

Sum these components to get the CIF price. For example, if the power supply costs €500, freight is €100, and insurance is €10, the CIF price would be €610.

Export Considerations from the Netherlands

Exports to EU countries may qualify as intra-Community supply, which is taxed at 0% VAT if the buyer is a registered business with a valid VAT number. Export documentation, including commercial invoice, packing list, and transport documents, must be prepared.
