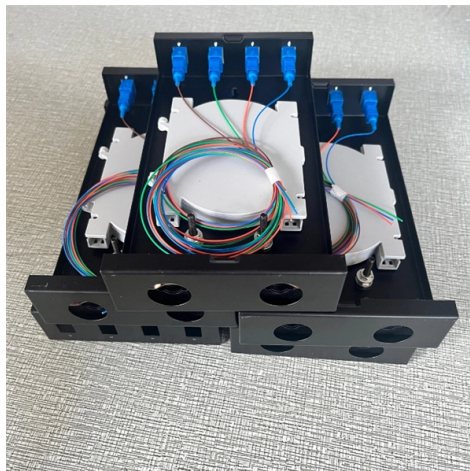


CWDM plug-in modules



AI Overview

CWDM plug-in modules enable the multiplexing and demultiplexing of multiple optical wavelengths over a single fiber, increasing network capacity without additional fiber deployment.

Overview Coarse Wavelength Division Multiplexing (CWDM) plug-in modules are optical components used to combine (multiplex) or separate (demultiplex) multiple wavelengths of light on a single fiber, allowing multiple data channels to coexist without interference. These modules are widely used in campus networks, data centers, metropolitan-area networks, and enterprise fiber networks to maximize fiber utilization and reduce infrastructure costs (Cisco, Aerech).

Types and Configurations

CWDM GBIC/SFP Modules These are transceiver plug-ins that fit into standard GBIC or SFP ports on network switches and routers. Each module operates on a specific wavelength (color) within the CWDM spectrum, typically ranging from 1470 nm to 1610 nm. They support 1.25 Gbps (SFP) and 10 Gbps (SFP+) speeds and can coexist in the same fiber link (MikroTik).

CWDM MUX/DEMUX Modules Passive optical modules that combine multiple CWDM channels into a single fiber or split them at the receiving end. Available in ABS pigtailed boxes, rack-mounted chassis, LGX cassettes, or FMU plug-in modules for flexible deployment (Aerech, PluginOptics). Standard configurations include 8-channel modules, often with an additional 1310 nm wideband port to support legacy circuits (PluginOptics).

Integrated Mux/Demux Modules Some modules combine both multiplexing and demultiplexing in a single unit, often with upgrade ports for future expansion (CubeOptics). These modules can be customized with LC or SC connectors and support simplex or duplex fiber configurations.

Key Features

Scalability: Modules allow incremental network expansion by adding wavelengths as needed.

Flexibility: Optional multi-function ports enable monitoring, capacity expansion, or integration of 1310 nm traffic (Aerech, PluginOptics).
