

Cable Tray Turning Tutorial

Offsets and Complex Turns: Use fabrication tables or guides to calculate the correct dimensions for offsets and angled turns. This ensures smooth transitions and proper alignment with other tray sections.

Safety Considerations

Clear the work area and ensure all tools are used correctly. Wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) when cutting or bending trays. Avoid intermixing high and low voltage wires to prevent electromagnetic interference and potential hazards. Restore the work area after completion and check all bends and cuts for accuracy and safety.
