

Cable laying sequence in cable trays

Cable laying in cable trays requires careful planning, proper tray selection, secure mounting, organized cable placement, and grounding to ensure safety and compliance.

Ensure trays are level, straight, and securely connected with fittings. Maintain proper spacing between stacked trays to allow cable laying and future maintenance.

Cable Laying Lay cables neatly within the tray, separating by voltage and function using cable ties or straps. Leave sufficient slack for expansion, movement, or future adjustments. Avoid sharp bends and kinks; for long runs, use cable tray rollers to facilitate smooth placement. Maintain fill limits: power cables should not exceed 40% of tray cross-section, and control cables 50%.

Grounding and Bonding For metallic trays, ensure proper grounding and bonding to maintain electrical continuity and safety. Use bonding jumpers across tray sections and verify compliance with NEC or local electrical standards.
