Horizontal bracing may be required, and double or triple bracing should be installed at designated locations to resist stress and deformation. The strength-stiffness ratio of the support system is critical to ensure the tray can bear loads without excessive deflection (WebPages). Seismic and Environmental Resistance: For civil defense and safety compliance, rooftop supports should resist seismic forces, corrosion, and environmental stresses. Lightweight, large-span designs are preferred for ease of construction while maintaining structural integrity (WebPages).
