- Cable Fill Ratio:** NEC recommends 40% fill for power cables and 50% for control cables to prevent overheating. Always include 25% spare capacity for future expansion.
- Load Capacity:** Material thickness and side rail height determine the maximum load. Ladder trays allow heavier loads and better ventilation, while perforated or wire mesh trays are suitable for lighter cables.
- Ventilation:** Ladder and perforated tees provide airflow to prevent heat buildup. Solid-bottom tees are used where aesthetics or minimal heat generation is required.

Practical Design Tips

- Match Tee Width to Main Tray:** Avoid narrowing the branch, which can cause cable congestion.
