- Solid Covers:** Provide full protection for sensitive cables like fiber optics or instrumentation.

Sizes and Load Ratings

- Widths:** Typically range from 50 mm to 900 mm, accommodating light, medium, and heavy-duty cable loads.
- Depths and part numbers:** are often specified using a system like CTUT (depth)/W1/W2 (finish), where W1 and W2 represent the widths of the main and branch runs.

- Used to branch cables from a main tray to equipment, devices, or secondary trays.
- Suitable for industrial, commercial, and data center installations where organized cable routing is essential.
- Can be integrated with ladder, perforated, solid-bottom, wire mesh, or channel trays depending on the project requirements.
