Perforated or wire mesh trays are preferred for heat dissipation, while solid trays may be used where aesthetics or protection from debris is important.

Installation and Fire Safety When trays pass close to walls, ensure firestopping measures are applied at wall penetrations. Use fire-rated boards, firestop packs, or mineral wool to seal gaps, with packing thickness not less than 24 cm and gaps around cables limited to 1 cm^2 . Install fire-support plates for large openings and ensure all seals are tight and free of cracks. Proper alignment and secure fixing of trays with cable ties or clips prevent movement and maintain system integrity.

Maintenance and Inspection Maintain easy access along the wall for routine inspection, cleaning, and cable replacement. Ensure tray connections are straight, properly aligned, and grounded. Periodically check for corrosion, deformation, or damage to fireproof coatings, especially in outdoor installations. By following these...
