Then, flip the breaker fully to OFF and back to ON to reset it . Main Breaker Use: The main breaker can shut off all power to the building. Use it during emergencies or when performing major electrical work . Safety Precautions Never touch live terminals; even when the main breaker is off, some parts may remain energized . Proper grounding is essential; ensure neutral and earth bars are correctly connected . Use correct breaker ratings for each circuit to prevent overheating or damage . Label circuits clearly to identify which breaker controls which area or appliance . Additional Tips Single-pole breakers are used for 120V circuits, while double-pole breakers are used for 240V circuits . Regularly inspect the panel for loose connections, corrosion, or overheating . Organize wiring neatly to facilitate ma...
