Powder Coating Powder coating is a highly versatile method for color matching galvanized trays. The process involves pretreatment (degreasing and phosphating), electrostatic application of a dry powder, and thermal curing to form a thick, durable layer (60–120 microns). Powder coating allows precise color matching using RAL or custom color charts, with options for gloss, matte, or textured finishes. It provides good chemical and physical resistance, making it suitable for indoor spaces like data centers, hospitals, and offices, and in some cases mild outdoor exposure. However, it does not offer sacrificial protection; deep scratches can lead to localized rust. Hot-Dip Galvanizing with Post-Treatment Color Hot-dip galvanizing (HDG) provides sacrificial corrosion protection by coating steel with a thick zinc layer that forms a protective patina over time. While HDG itself is typically silver-gray, post-treatment methods such as powder coating or specialized paints can be applied for color matching. This approach combines the long-term corrosion resistance of HDG with the aesthetic flexibility of...
