For three-phase four-wire systems used in distribution boxes, the standard wire colors must be followed: Phase A - Yellow, Phase B - Green, Phase C - Red, Neutral wire - Light Blue, Protective Earth wire - Yellow/Green bi-color. The IEC 60446 standard, "Basic and Safety Principles for Man-Machine. A distribution box is a low-voltage electrical enclosure that receives incoming power and distributes it safely to multiple outgoing circuits through protective and switching devices such as MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, isolators, busbars, neutral bars, earth bars, and surge protective devices. The. These color codes are used for electrical distribution systems, and while some are mandatory, others are optional. Proper identification prevents hazards, streamlines maintenance, and ensures.
