OM4 (50 μm core, enhanced laser-optimized): Backward compatible with OM3, supports 10G Ethernet up to 550 meters, 40G/100G up to 150 meters. Ideal for high-performance data centers and long-distance 10G+ links ().

OM5 (50 μm core, SWDM-enabled): Supports Short Wavelength Division Multiplexing (SWDM), allowing multiple wavelengths over a single fiber. Designed for future-proofing high-speed, multi-wavelength applications in data centers ().

Price Comparison

OM1: \$2.50–\$4.00 per foot, depending on indoor/outdoor, plenum, or riser-rated cables ().

OM3: \$3.28–\$4.50 per foot, with riser and plenum options affecting cost ().

OM4: \$4.50–\$5.50 per foot for standard ratings; specialized or armored versions can reach \$13.50 per foot ().

OM5: Typically higher than OM4 due to SWDM capabilities, though exact pricing varies by vendor and application ().
