Network Overview Afghan Telecom operates a government-owned fiber optic network connecting 24 provinces, with international links to Pakistan, Iran, Tajikistan, Uzbekistan, and Turkmenistan, and plans to extend to China. The network uses FTTH architecture, where optical fibers run from a central office (OLT) directly to subscriber premises (ONU/ONT), often passing through splitters in the Optical Distribution Network (ODN). Switches in this network manage traffic between OLTs, ONUs, and the broader IP backbone. Switch Configuration Steps Hardware Setup Install the fiber optic switch in a secure, climate-controlled environment. Connect the switch to the OLT and core network using fiber uplinks. Ensure proper licensing for advanced features if using Cisco or similar switches, such as Fibre Channel or FCoE capabilities. Port Configuration Assign physical ports as uplinks (to OLT or core network) or downlinks (to ONUs or local distribution nodes). Configure port modes: E (Expansion), F (Fabric), TE (Trunk Expansion), or SD (Server Direct) depending on network topology. Enable VSAN or VLAN segmentation to isolate traffic for different services (internet, voice, video). Service Definition Configure the OLT to define services delivered to ONUs/ONTs, including bandwidth allocation and Quality of Service (QoS) policies. Map each ONU/ONT to the appropriate service profile on the switch. Security and Management Implement encryption and access control to protect data across the fiber network. Enable monitoring and logging for operational status, port activity, and signal quality. Schedule firmware updates for both switches and ONUs to maintain security and performance.
