Evaluate environmental factors like temperature, humidity, vibration, and electromagnetic interference (EMI) to select switches with appropriate ruggedization and IP ratings.

Basic Configuration

- IP Addressing:** Assign a static IP, subnet mask, and default gateway to enable remote management.
- Port Configuration:** Set port speed, duplex mode, and VLAN assignments according to network design.
- Security:** Enable access control lists (ACLs), MAC address filtering, strong passwords, and disable unused ports to prevent unauthorized access.

Advanced Features: Configure QoS for prioritizing critical traffic, link aggregation for bandwidth optimization, and spanning tree protocols (RSTP or proprietary ring protocols) for redundancy.

Network Topology and Redundancy Industrial networks often use ring topologies for high reliability, allowing automatic network healing within milliseconds if a link fails. Implement redundant power supplies and consider dual-homing or backup links to minimize downtime.

Layer 2 managed switches handle MAC-based forwarding, while **Layer 3 switches** support routing between subnets with static routes, RIP, or VRRP for larger networks.
