Plug in Fiber: Insert the LC connectors into the SFP modules on both switches, ensuring a secure fit. Verify Link: Check the switch LEDs or management interface to confirm the fiber link is active. Additional Considerations Distance and Fiber Type: For short runs (under 300 meters), multi-mode fiber (OM2 or OM3) is sufficient. For longer distances, single-mode fiber is recommended. Network Topology: You can connect switches in a star or daisy-chain topology. Star topology is preferred for performance, with a central switch managing traffic. Safety and Handling: Avoid bending fiber sharply, and protect outdoor runs with conduit if burying the cable. By following these steps and using compatible SF...
