- Cable entry/exit ports with grommets to prevent fraying and dust ingress.
- Splice trays for fusion splicing fibers to pigtails, ensuring proper slack storage, bend-radius compliance, and stress relief.
- Breakout plates or horizontal/vertical plates to secure cable sheaths, central strength members, Kevlar, and tubes before directing fibers into splice trays.
- Adapters and holders for connectors and splice protectors, which shield fibers from mechanical stress and contamination.
- Slide-out trays or modular panels in rack-mounted ODFs for easy fiber management and future scalability.

Fiber Management and Protection

ODFs are engineered to minimize signal loss and accidental damage. Fibers are typically arranged in bundles of 12 or 24 fibers per tube, with standard cables accommodating up to 96 fibers. Microcables and microducts may require additional vertical routing racks near the ODF for proper fixation. The design ensures organized routing, bend-radius compliance, and protection from environmental factors such as dust, moisture, and mechanical stress.
