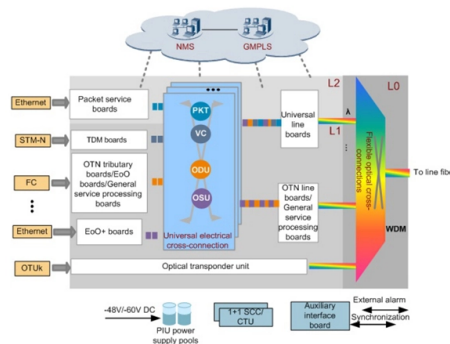


Core Switch Installation



AI Overview

Installing a core switch involves careful preparation, hardware setup, cabling, configuration, and verification to ensure minimal network downtime and reliable operation.

Preparation and Pre-Installation Steps Before installing a core switch, assess the existing network environment. Ensure the cabinet is organized and check for any cabling issues. If significant work is anticipated, notify the delivery engineer and document any infrastructure problems with photos for later reference. Review the Statement of Work to identify any deviations that may require additional time or materials, such as de-racking and replacing the existing switch while migrating fiber and Ethernet connections.

Hardware Setup

Rack Installation: Mount the switch securely in the rack, ensuring proper airflow and cooling. Follow the manufacturer's guidelines for chassis installation and grounding.

Power and Grounding: Connect AC power modules and ensure the switch is properly grounded. Verify that power redundancy is configured if supported.

Modules and Transceivers: Install any required plug-in modules or SFP transceivers according to the switch specifications.

Cabling and Connectivity

Fiber and Ethernet Migration: Carefully migrate existing cables from the old switch to the new core switch. Label and document each connection to avoid misconfiguration.

Minimizing Downtime: If replacing an existing core switch, consider connecting the new switch to the old one temporarily or using extra ports in a down state. Configure SVIs and IP addresses on the new switch in shutdown mode, then bring them online during the maintenance window to reduce downtime.

Configuration

Initial Setup: Configure the switch with the required VLANs, IP addresses, routing protocols, and security settings. Follow the manufacturer's installation guide for device-specific configuration steps.

Testing: Verify connectivity, redundancy, and performance. Ensure all connected devices, including firewalls, servers, and access switches, communicate correctly through the new core switch
