

Delivery of Micro-Modules in Ireland



AI Overview

Micro-modules in Ireland are delivered either as educational units in schools or as renewable energy systems, each with structured support and flexible implementation.

Educational Micro-Modules (Transition Year) In the Transition Year (TY) programme, micro-modules are designed to provide concentrated learning experiences for students, enhancing their educational journey within the senior cycle framework. These modules can be delivered as standalone components or integrated with other TY activities. Schools have flexibility in determining the duration, typically 10, 20, or 30 hours, and the balance between class contact time and independent learning. The delivery process involves several steps:

- Scoping phase** to identify the need and purpose of the module.
- Design and development** using the TY micro-module template provided by the NCCA, which includes guidance on key competencies, literacies, and numeracy.
- Implementation** in schools, allowing students to engage actively, develop autonomy, and explore a range of learning pathways.
- Evaluation and feedback**, which can inform future iterations of the module.

Micro-Generation Energy Modules In the context of renewable energy, micro-modules refer to small-scale energy generation systems, such as solar PV panels, micro-wind, or micro-hydro systems. Delivery in Ireland involves:

- Procurement:** Solar PV modules and microinverters are stocked by suppliers like Kelliher's Electrical, with options for next-day delivery across Ireland.
- Installation:** Modules can be installed for domestic, commercial, or community use, often supported by grants under the Microgeneration Support Scheme (MSS).
- Grid integration:** Micro-generators primarily serve their own consumption but can export excess electricity to the grid under the MSS, receiving payments via the Clean Export Guarantee (CEG).
