

Depth of underground laying of instrument fiber optic cables



Overview

Depths in the range of 24-48 inches (60-120 cm) are typical to protect against plows and wildlife. With international fiber networks predicted to grow to over 1.8 million km in scope by 2025 (per TeleGeography), burying these cords of light comes with the benefits of avoiding cable damage, decreasing downtime, and extending their operational lifetime. But how deep is fiber optic cable buried?

The short answer, based on general industry standards and the National Electrical Code (NEC), is that fiber optic cable is typically buried between 24 inches (60 cm) and 30 inches (76 cm) deep. Project success depends on careful planning, precise installation practices, and proper. Underground cables are pulled in conduit that is buried underground, usually 1-1.2 meters (3-4 feet) deep to reduce the likelihood of accidentally being dug up. In extreme cold climates, cables may need to be buried at greater depths where temperatures are colder and frost penetrates to. When planning a fiber optic network installation, one of the most common questions is: How deep are fiber optic cables buried?
