Switched/Intelligent PDUs: Feature remote outlet control and advanced monitoring. These units may be 2U high and longer in depth to accommodate additional circuitry, sometimes exceeding 1.5 meters in length. Mounting and Clearance Considerations PDUs are designed to fit vertically along the side or rear of server racks, minimizing obstruction to IT equipment. Side-mount PDUs are typically narrower (less than 2 inches wide), while rear-mounted units may extend deeper to allow for cable retention and airflow management. Clearance for cabling and airflow should be considered, especially in high-density LAN environments.
