

Dimensions of cable tray cover plates

Proper thickness ensures the cover can withstand mechanical stress and environmental exposure. Selection Considerations Tray Type: Solid, ventilated, or ladder trays may require different cover designs. Solid trays use full covers, while ventilated trays may use perforated covers to allow airflow. Cable Volume: Ensure the cover does not restrict cable installation or exceed the tray's fill ratio (commonly 40% for power cables, 50% for control cables). Future Expansion: Include at least 25% spare capacity in width and height to accommodate additional cables over time. Environmental Factors: Consider corrosion resistance, temperature, and exposure to dust or moisture when selecting cover material and thickness. Practical Tip When ordering or fabricating cover plates, always match the nominal tray width and depth rather than the external dimensions, as side rails add extra width. This ensures a snug fit, proper cable protection, and compliance with NEC or IEC standards.
