Thickness varies by material and load capacity: Galvanized cable tray thickness must meet ASTM A653 standards for corrosion. In practice, cable tray dimensions are a system of interrelated measurements—width, depth, length, and material thickness—that directly affect cable fill compliance, heat dissipation, structural loading, and long-term expandability.
