- External Inspection:** Check for dust caps, debris, or visible damage. Keep dust caps on until ready to handle the optical connectors.
- Opening the Module Housing:** Some modules, like XENPAK or early 10G transceivers, have screws or clips securing the metal casing. Carefully remove these while keeping track of small parts. Avoid bending or scratching the metal casing, as it may affect heat dissipation and structural integrity.
- Internal Component Handling:** Inside, you may find the laser assembly, optical multiplexer/demultiplexer, and PCB with parallel electrical paths. Handle the PCB and optical components by the edges; do not touch the laser diodes or lenses. If removing the laser assembly, note the orientation and connections for reassembly.
- Cleaning and Maintenance:** Use lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol for cleaning optical lenses if necessary. Avoid touching optical surf...
