- Neutral and earth bars:** Provide safe return paths and grounding for electrical circuits.
- Protective enclosure:** Prevents accidental contact with live parts and ensures safety.

Modern distribution boxes may also include RCDs, RCBOs, surge protection devices, and energy monitoring units for enhanced safety and efficiency. They are available in various types for residential, commercial, industrial, or outdoor applications, and can handle single-phase or three-phase power systems depending on the installation requirements.
