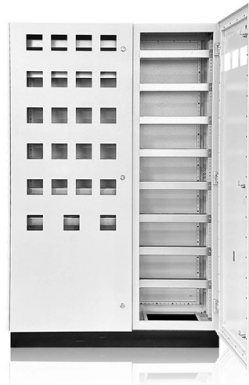


Distribution box output wires

Overview of Output Wiring In a distribution box, the output wires are the conductors that connect the circuit breakers (MCBs) or RCCBs to the respective electrical loads such as lighting, sockets, or appliances. - Neutral Wire:** The neutral wire from the output of the RCCB or neutral link is connected to the load's neutral terminal. This ensures a complete circuit for current return ().
- Earth Wire:** The earth wire connects the metallic parts of the load and the distribution box to the earth link, providing protection against electric shock ().

Wire Sizes

- Lighting and socket circuits:** Typically use 2.5 mm² wires.
- Air conditioning or high-power circuits:** May use 2.5 mm² or 4.0 mm² wires, depending on load requirements ().

Wiring Practices

- Direction:** Wiring from the main circuit breaker to branch MCBs is usually on the left, while wiring exiting the distribution box goes to the right ().
- Binding:** Wires should be neatly tied with plastic ties, spaced uniformly to prevent tangling and ensure straight runs ().
- Marking:** AC, DC, or different voltage levels should be clearly marked on the wires for safety and maintenance ().

Safety Inspection: After wiring, inspect for short circuits, loose connections, or overload risks before energizing the system ().
