- Regional Variations:** Always verify local codes, as colors may differ slightly between countries or older installations.
- Old vs. New Wiring:** Older systems may use outdated colors; labeling is recommended when mixing old and new wires.
- Safety First:** Never assume a wire's function based solely on color; always test before handling.
- Documentation:** Distribution boxes should have clear labeling for each terminal and wire to prevent miswiring and simplify maintenance.

By following these color standards, electricians and technicians can safely identify and work with live, neutral, and ground wires in distribution boxes, ensuring compliance with local regulations and reducing the risk of electrical hazards.
