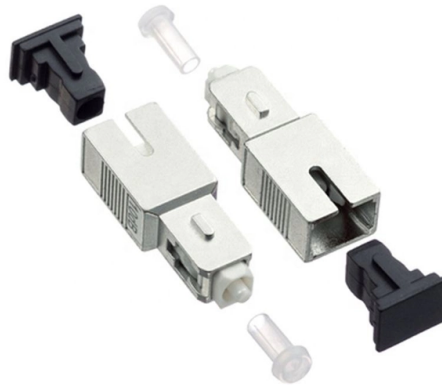

- Safety warnings (e.g., high voltage, PCB content)

The National Electrical Code (NEC) specifies installation and protection requirements, such as spacing for ventilation, guarding against physical damage, and grounding. For example, pad-mounted transformers in public areas may require bollards or fencing to prevent vehicle damage.
