- Main Breaker or Main Isolator:** The incoming phase and neutral wires connect here. It allows the entire system to be disconnected during maintenance or emergencies.
- Branch Circuit Breakers:** Each circuit breaker receives a connection from the busbar (phase) and routes power to individual circuits. Single-pole breakers disconnect only the live wire, while double-pole breakers disconnect both live and neutral for higher safety.

Busbars: Metal strips that distribute power from the main breaker to all branch breakers. They provide a stable and organized connection point for multiple circuits.

Wiring Layout and Safety

Wires should be neatly organized to prevent overcrowding, overheating, or accidental contact with live parts. Color coding is essential: typically, red or brown for live, blue for neutral, and green/yellow for earth.

Residual Current Devices (RCDs) or RCCBs are often installed to detect leakage currents and cut off power instantly, enhancing safety.

Proper labeling of wires and breakers ensures easy identification and maintenance.
