

Dmz aggregation switch



Overview

Aggregation layer uses dual L3 switches (Agg-SW-01 and Agg-SW-02) for load distribution, feeding four L2 access switches that connect end devices across seven VLANs (Office, Finance, R&D, Management, WiFi, Web, Database). This section provides information for network engineering teams responsible for the deployment of event brokers (specifically Solace Appliance Event Broker s) in the DMZ to provide high-availability connectivity into the underlying Layer 2 switch infrastructure.
