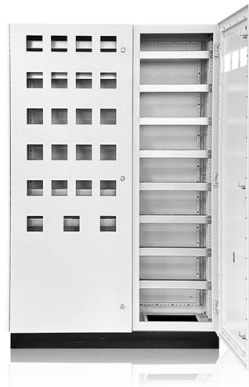

In these environments, explosion-proof enclosures are designed to contain internal explosions and prevent ignition of the surrounding atmosphere, using reinforced enclosures and flame paths to cool escaping gases . Equipment must meet standards such as NEC Class I/II, ATEX, or IECEx depending on the region and hazard classification . Key Considerations Not all server racks need explosion-proof ratings; over-specifying in non-hazardous areas adds unnecessary cost without improving safety . Installation requirements for explosion-proof equipment are stricter, including proper conduit sealing, thread engagement, and cable entry methods to maintain protection ratings . Risk assessment is essential: only areas with persistent flammable atmospheres require explosion-proof racks, while standard UL 2416 racks suffice for typical IT en...
