What is grounding? The term grounding is commonly used in the electrical industry to mean both "equipment grounding" and "system grounding".

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Why are Neutral and Ground Wires Separated in a Subpanel?

In a service equipment (main panel) and remote distribution panel (subpanel), the ground terminal must be connected to a ground rod using an equipment grounding conductor.

Equipment Grounding

Main Distribution Board: When it comes to commercial buildings, the main distribution board is grounded through the use of a grounding electrode system, just like it is in residential structures.

DISTRIBUTION BOX

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.
