Observe the swarf: clean, short, helical chips indicate proper speed and feed; dark or irregular chips suggest overheating or incorrect technique. Safety and Finishing Wear safety goggles, gloves, and dust mask to protect against sharp swarf and metal particles. After drilling, deburr edges using a file or sandpaper to prevent injuries and maintain tray integrity. Avoid excessive pressure to prevent bit breakage and tray deformation. Best Practices Drill between existing holes when possible to maintain structural strength. Provide rigid support for the tray to prevent chipping at edges. For repetitive or precise drilling, consider pre-drilled trays or drilling jigs for splice connections.
