Overview

In 1970, scientists Robert Maurer, Donald Keck, and Peter Schultz at Corning Glass Works made a pivotal breakthrough: they created the first low-loss optical fiber capable of transmitting light over long distances. Charles Kao of Standard Telephone and Cables (UK) reveals on how to make low loss fiber suitable for communications using an optical cladding over a pure glass core and removing impurities, plus ideally singlemode operation. (Awarded Nobel Prize in 2009) Ethernet was invented at Xerox Palo Alto. In the 1960s at Standard Telecommunication Laboratories (STL) based in Harlow, Essex, England, Kao and his coworkers did their pioneering work in creating fibre optics as a telecommunications medium, by demonstrating that the high-loss of existing fibre optics arose from impurities in the glass, rather than from an underlying problem with the technology itself.
