

Electronic-to-optical port module switch

Electronic-to-optical port module switches convert electrical signals into optical signals for high-speed data transmission, enabling integration between copper-based networks and fiber-optic systems.

Overview An electronic-to-optical port module switch is a device that allows electrical signals from standard network interfaces (like RJ45 Ethernet ports) to be converted into optical signals for transmission over fiber-optic cables. These modules are typically hot-swappable and conform to SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) standards, making them compatible with switches, routers, and network interface cards (NICs) for short- or long-reach applications.

Electrical Port Modules Electrical port modules, also called optical-to-electrical port converters, use UTP copper cables for transmission and are primarily designed for short-reach data transmission (less than 100 meters). They support speeds ranging from 100 Mbps to 10 Gbps, depending on the module type:

- Fast Ethernet modules:** Up to 100 Mbps
- Gigabit modules:** Up to 1 Gbps, supporting SGMII or 1000BASE-X modes
- 10 Gigabit modules:** Up to 10 Gbps for 10G SFP ports

These modules allow existing copper cabling to connect servers and switches without requiring fiber upgrades.

Optical Port Modules and Switches Optical port modules convert electrical signals into light for transmission over fiber. They are often integrated with MEMS-based optical switches for routing and distribution. Key features include:
