

Fabrication and Installation of Stainless Steel Straight-Through Cable Trays

Installation Procedure

Route Marking and Clearance: Mark horizontal and vertical tray routes according to approved drawings, ensuring no clashes with other services and maintaining sufficient clearance for cable pulling and future maintenance.

Support System: Install threaded rod supports with metal anchors, fixing 'L' angles or slotted 'C' channels at a maximum spacing of 1.2 meters to prevent sagging. Additional supports are required at bends, branches, and offsets.

Tray Assembly: Position straight-through sections and secure them to the supports using bolts and nuts. Ensure proper alignment and level throughout the run. For vertical or non-horizontal installations, cables must be tied down to maintain spacing...
