- Color coding:** Jacket colors follow TIA-598-D standards—yellow for single-mode, aqua or orange for multimode fibers. Color coding can also extend to labels or bands for quick visual identification.

Key Labeling Components

- Cable Identifier:** Unique alphanumeric code for each cable.
- Source and Destination:** Clearly indicate the start and end points (e.g., "Server Rack 12A to IDF-3").
- Cable Specifications:** Include fiber type (single-mode/multimode), strand count, and OM3/OM4 designation if applicable.
- Installation Date:** Helps track cable age and maintenance schedules (e.g., "Inst: 03/2024").

Best Practices and Compliance

- Use machine-generated labels for consistency and durability; thermal printing is preferred for long-term readability.
- Maintain up-to-date documentation in parallel with physical labels; consider integrating QR codes, RFID, or NFC for digital tracking and DCIM software integration.
