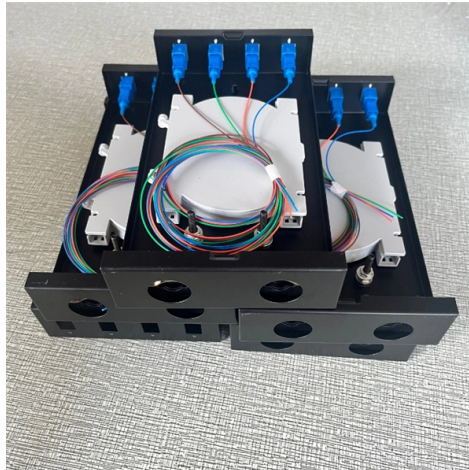


Fiber Optic Cable Splicing Schedule

 - Mechanical Splicing (5–15 minutes total):** Fibers are held together in a mechanical connector without melting. Faster but generally used for temporary or field repairs.
- 5. Splice Protection (2–5 minutes)** Apply heat-shrink sleeves or protective enclosures to reinforce the splice and prevent mechanical damage.
- 6. Testing and Verification (5–10 minutes)** Use an Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer (OTDR) or insertion loss meter to verify splice quality and measure signal loss. Ensures the splice meets network performance standards.

Factors Affecting Splicing Time

- Technician experience:** Skilled technicians complete splices faster and with fewer errors.
- Number of fibers:** Multi-fiber cables (e.g., 12 or 48 fibers) increase total splicing time.
- Equipment quality:** Advanced fusion splicers with automatic calibration reduce alignment and fusion time.
- Environmental conditions:** Field conditions like temperature, dust, or confined spaces can slow the process.
