While there are several specific types of listings for power cables, specifically for tray applications, there is no equivalent tray rating for optical fiber cables. According to the 2023 National Electric Code® (NEC), any listed optical fiber cable is acceptable. Type OFN-OPC- Optical Fiber - (NEC Article 770) - Fiber optic (or “optical fiber”) refers to the medium and the technology associated with the transmission of information as light impulses along a glass or plastic wire or fiber. Fiber optic wire carries much more information than conventional. compact, and bend radius.
