- SFP Modules:** Small-Form Factor Pluggable (SFP) or QSFP modules are used to connect switches via fiber. Compatibility with the switch model is essential to ensure proper operation.
- Distance Limitations:** While fiber allows longer distances than copper, the maximum distance depends on the type of fiber (single-mode or multi-mode) and the SFP module specifications.
- Stacking Topology:** Switches can be stacked in a ring or daisy-chain configuration. Some vendors provide specialized stacking ports or cables, while others allow stacking over standard uplink ports using fiber.
