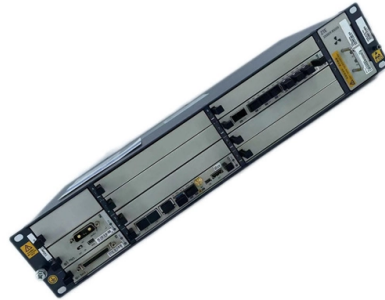

Tools: Fish tape, cable-pulling lubricant, and flexible low-voltage conduit help route cables safely through walls, ceilings, or floors without damaging the delicate fiber core.

Installation Considerations

Pathway Planning: Identify the shortest, straightest route from the service entry point to each room. Use existing conduits or abandoned cable runs when possible to minimize bends and stress on the fiber.

Protection: Use flexible conduits in open wall cavities or high-traffic areas to prevent accidental damage, pests, or future renovation interference.

Bend Radius: Avoid sharp bends to prevent macrobends or microbends, which can cause signal attenuation.

Environmental Factors: Keep fiber away from heat sources, uninsulated attics, or areas with extreme temperature fluctuations to maintain performance.

Integration with Wi-Fi FTTR solutions often include Wi-Fi 6 master/slave units that support OFDMA, MU-MIMO, and 1024-QAM, allowing multiple devices to connect simultaneously with minimal interf...
