Types of Fiber Optic Cables Fiber optic cables are categorized based on the number of light modes they support: Single-mode fiber (SMF): Has a small core (~9 microns) that allows only one light mode to propagate, enabling long-distance, high-speed transmission with minimal signal loss . Multi-mode fiber (MMF): Has a larger core (50–100 microns) that supports multiple light modes, suitable for shorter distances and high-bandwidth applications within buildings or campuses . Cables also vary by construction, such as loose-tube for outdoor use and tight-buffered for indoor installations, and by connector types, which are selected b...
