

Fiber optic cable laying requirements for second-level construction engineer exam mechanical and electrical

Fiber optic cable installation requires adherence to mechanical handling, electrical testing, and safety standards to ensure network integrity and compliance with industry norms.

Mechanical Requirements

Cable Handling and Storage: Fiber optic cables must be handled carefully to prevent damage. Protective material on reels should remain in place until installation, and cables should not be bent sharply or pulled over edges. Figure-8 loops are recommended during storage and pulling to prevent twisting and kinking, with typical loop sizes of 2-4 meters depending on cable stiffness (Belden Guidelines), . LSZH sheathed cables are particularly sensitive to mechanical stress and temperature variations.

Trenching and Duct Installation: For underground installations, trenches should be excavated with care to avoid existing utilities. Cable rollers should be placed at intervals of approximately 2 meters to prevent mechanical damage during pulling. Corners, road crossings, and existing ducts require special attention with appropriate corner rollers and smooth pulling techniques (Underground Cable Laying Method Statement), . Protective tiles and warning tapes should be installed above the cable before backfilling.

Bending Radius and Pulling Tension: Maintain the minimum bending radius specified by the manufacturer, typically 10-20 times the cable diameter for single-mode fibers. Pulling tension must not exceed the cable's rated maximum to avoid microbending or macrobending losses (FOA Installation Standard), .

Testing and Verification: After installation, perform sheath testing and insulation resistance measurements using a DC HV test kit or meggering equipment. For armored cables,...
