

Fiber optic cable splice colors

Standard Fiber Color Sequence

For most fiber optic cables, the TIA-598-C standard defines a 12-color sequence for identifying individual fibers: Blue, Orange, Green, Brown, Slate (Gray), White, Red, Black, Yellow, Violet, Rose (Pink), Aqua (Light Blue). - Tube 2: Fibers 13–24 (Blue to Aqua, with tube color coding)
- Tube 3: Fibers 25–36
- Tube 4: Fibers 37–48

Each tube may have a distinct tube color (e.g., Blue, Orange, Green, etc.) to help identify the fiber's position within the cable.

Ribbon and Tight-Buffered Cables

Ribbon cables: Fibers are arranged side-by-side in ribbons, and each ribbon follows the 12-color sequence. Multiple ribbons repeat the sequence for higher fiber counts, simplifying splicing by matching ribbon layers.

Tight-buffered cables: Common in indoor applications, these cables use the same 12-color sequence for individual fibers, often with printed legends or stripes to differentiate repeated groups.

Connector and Jacket Color Coding

Cable jackets: Indicate fiber type (e.g., yellow for singlemode, orange for 62.5/125 multimode, aqua for 50/125 laser-optimized multimode) and help technicians quickly identify the cable type.

Connectors: Color-coded to match fiber type and polish type (e.g., blue for singlemode PC, green for singlemode APC, beige for multimode 62.5/125, aqua for multimode 50/125 laser-optimized).

Always match fiber colors when splicing to maintain correct polarity and avoid misconnection. For high-count cables, identify both the tube color and the fiber color inside the tube to locate the...
