 - Wall-mounted trays: Use wall anchors and NKP-SNT brackets, securing with flange nuts.
 - Ceiling-mounted trays: Use NKP-PL profiles, threaded rods, and anchor bolts.Maintain load-bearing elements spaced ≤ 1.2 meters and a minimum 25 cm clearance from the ceiling. Ensure the tray load does not exceed the rated capacity, typically 10 kg/m for lightweight systems.
- 4. Fireproofing Measures**Apply fire-retardant coatings to tray surfaces to slow flame spread. Install fire barriers within trays to isolate different fire zones. Seal openings where trays pass through walls or floors using fire-rated penetration materials such as firestop packs, mastic, or mineral wool. Ensure gaps are minimal and backing pla...
