

Fusion end cold connector

A fusion end cold connector, also called a fiber fast connector or mechanical splice, is a field-installable fiber optic connector that terminates fiber without fusion splicing, enabling quick, reliable connections.

Overview A cold connector is a type of fiber optic connector that mechanically joins two fibers using a pre-installed fiber stub and index-matching gel or mechanical clamping, rather than fusing the fibers with heat. This allows for fast, on-site installation without specialized fusion splicing equipment, making it ideal for FTTH deployments, emergency repairs, or small-scale projects.

How It Works The bare fiber is inserted into the connector body. A V-shaped groove or alignment mechanism ensures precise fiber core alignment. Index-matching gel reduces optical loss at the joint. The connector is then secured, creating a stable optical path without welding.

Types and Standards

- SC/APC Cold Connectors:** Feature an 8-degree angled endface polish, providing return loss $\geq 60\text{dB}$, commonly used in GPON, EPON, and CATV networks.
- SC/UPC Cold Connectors:** Use ultra-physical contact polish with return loss $\geq 50\text{dB}$, suitable for general FTTH applications.

Advantages

- Quick and easy installation without electricity or fusion splicing equipment.
- Portable and convenient for field deployment.
- Lower cost for small-scale or temporary connections.
- Safe for fibers, avoiding heat or adhesives that could damage the fiber.

Limitations

- Higher insertion loss compared to fusion splicing, which may affect signal quality over long distances.
- Environmental sensitivity: Connection quality can be influenced by dust, humidity, or temperature.

Not ideal for high-bandwidth or long-haul networks, where fusion splicing provides lower loss and higher reliability.

Applications

- FTTH drop cable terminations at customer premises.
- Patch connections within distribution boxes.
- Emergency repairs or temporary network setups.
- Quick field testing and small-scale installations.
