

# Home Fiber Optic Networking

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT):** Converts light signals from the fiber into electrical signals for your router. It is usually installed near your electrical panel or outside your home.
- Router or Gateway:** Distributes internet to devices via Wi-Fi or Ethernet. Modern routers supporting Wi-Fi 6 or higher are recommended to fully utilize fiber speeds.
- Ethernet Cables:** High-quality Cat6 or better cables connect the ONT to the router, ensuring stable data transfer.
- Optional Media Converters or Fiber Switches:** For extending fiber to multiple buildings or outdoor devices, fiber-to-Ethernet converters or fiber switches can maintain electrical isolation and high bandwidth.

**Installation Process**

Fiber installation typically involves:

- Running a fiber drop from the neighborhood terminal to your home, either overhead or underground.
- Connecting the fiber to a Network Interface Device (NID) outside your home.
- Linking the fiber to the ONT, which converts light signals to electrical signals.
- Connecting the ONT to your router via Ethernet for Wi-Fi distribution.
- Testing and activating the connection to ensure full speed and signal quality.
