 - 1P+N (Single Pole + Neutral):** Protects both live and neutral wires.
 - 2P (Double Pole):** Protects both wires, ideal for high-power appliances.
- Load Balancing:** Distribute appliances and sockets evenly across the two circuits to prevent overloading one side and ensure stable operation.
- Safety and Future-Proofing:** Leave extra space in the distribution box for future expansion or additional breakers. Follow local electrical c...
