Wire Sizing: Wires must be sized according to the current rating of the circuit. For example, a 4 mm² copper wire can carry up to 25A, and a 6 mm² wire up to 32A, following national standards. Prohibited Methods: Jumpers A jumper connection, where a wire from the main breaker feeds the first branch breaker and then additional wires are daisy-chained to subsequent breakers, is explicitly prohibited. This method can overload wires, create excessive heat, and pose fire hazards because the first wire carries the sum of currents from multiple circuits. Modern standards require each breaker to have a dedicated connection to the main...
